TASTING NOTES

This wine demonstrates the Bordelaise style - complexity, finesse, with structure for aging. A ripe vintage, with lifted notes of crushed black cherries, charcoal and tobacco flowers, on the finish. This elegant wine is Dylan and Pénélope's love story in a bottle.

FOOD PAIRING

Peking duck. Charred, grilled red peppers and lamb kebabs. French onion soup. Sharp, powerful cheeses. Bitter, high cocoa chocolate. Birthdays.

TRADE DESCRIPTION

Right Bank opulence with refreshingly high acid. Full bodied, deeply dark and brooding. Complex, with satin tannins.

WINEMAKING

Stainless steel fermented.

AGING

Aged for 12 months in French oak, 10% new for subtle cinnamon notes.

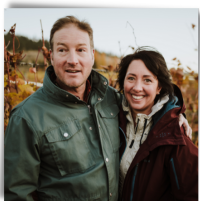

TERROIR

The Merlot comes from Kozier organic vineyard on the Naramata Bench. The Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc come from the Suncrest Vineyard in Oliver where the terroir mainly consists of sand, with small pockets of gravel. With around 2040 hours of sunshine per year and less than 20 centimetres of rainfall, this is the perfect place to ripen Bordeaux varieties.
